Looking ahead to next term, we have arranged various exciting opportunities for the Year 6 children (in addition to PGL!):

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TRIPS:

Picnic at Court Park

- This event will only go ahead if the weather is on our side!
- Children can wear their own clothes to school that day (but should be dressed appropriately for a picnic in the park).
- We'll leave school at the beginning of lunch time (12:20pm); parents are welcome to join us for the walk or to meet us at the park during the afternoon. We'll return to school before the end of the school day.

iBooks Author sessions @ Apple Store

- Children should arrive at school at normal time, wearing their school uniform and a jacket.
- Children will need to bring a packed lunch – no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please.
- Children can bring up to £3.00 spending money for an ice cream.
- Children should be back at Oak Farm before the end of the school day.



Legoland

- We'll be leaving school at 9:15am and aim to return at 5:45pm.
- Children will need to bring a packed lunch – no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please.
- Children can wear their own (but suitable!) clothes and should bring a swimming costume and towel if they want to visit the 'Splash Safari'. Depending on the weather, children may also need to bring a hat and sun cream.
- Children can bring cameras (no phones please) and up to £10 spending money but these will be their own responsibility.
- When we are in the park, the children will be in small groups (5-6) with a group leader; they will not be allowed to wander around on their own. No child will be pressured into going on any ride they don't feel comfortable with.
