SATs breakfast

SATs timetable

Overleaf is a timetable so you know which tests your child will be doing each day. It is imperative that children are in school every morning, even if they are feeling a bit 'under the weather'.

End of SATs celebration

To celebrate the end of SATs week we are planning to take Year 6 to Court Park for a picnic (and to play some games!) on the afternoon of Friday 12th May, weather permitting.

Your child will need to bring with them a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). If your child requires a Pabulum packed lunch, please let us know in advance (Wednesday 10th May at the latest). If it is very sunny, it would be advisable for your child to bring a hat, sun cream and extra drinks. Ideally, your child's lunch should be in a plastic bag which can easily be thrown away.
