Dear Parents

Free School Meals Entitlement

If you think your child may be entitled to Free School Meals, would you please apply through the office, even if your child does not want to have school meals. The school receives extra funding for this, even if the children actually eat packed lunches.

This extra funding is spent on supporting your child in school. This can be done in a variety of ways from funding additional support with work to providing support with paying for residential trips.

Your child may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are entitled to receive one or more of the following:

- Income Support (IS);
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA);
- An income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999; or
- Child Tax Credit provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed £16,190.
The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.

If your child is currently receiving free school meals and you have not reapplied this year, please complete the form available from reception, or on our website and return to Mrs. Kanda. The Local Borough requests that there is an application form signed by the parent/carer and evidence of eligibility provided annually.
