

Oak Farm Junior School Admissions Policy Consultation

What changes are being proposed?

No changes are being proposed to the existing admissions policy.

If no changes are being proposed, why are you having a consultation process?

All schools are required by law to consult on their admissions policy at least every 7 years - even if no changes are proposed.

Although the governors regularly review the policy and believe it is serving the school and local community well any comments or suggestions will be carefully considered. It is important for the school to have some external opinions when considering such important decisions.

Do children automatically transfer from Oak Farm Infant School?

The Junior School reserves a place for all Infant Children and works closely with the Local Authority to simplify the admissions process. London Borough of Hillingdon will automatically apply for a place in the Junior School for all Infant Children who are Hillingdon residents. Any Infant pupil who is not currently residing within the Borough of Hillingdon needs to formally apply through the Local Authority where they live. Please inform the Junior School Office if you do not require a place in the Junior School or if you have any questions.
