

**Oak Farm Junior School Uniform Policy**

We expect that all parents will ensure that their children wear the correct school uniform. We believe that it is important for the children to maintain a smart, yet practical, appearance and it gives the children a feeling of identity and pride in the school, as well as themselves. It gives a sense of equality amongst peers and it makes life simpler for parents when it comes to clothing their children for school.

The school will respect variations to the uniform policy if they are directly in relation to religious, cultural or medical reasons. Variations will be dealt with on an individual basis and judgements will remain the discretion of the head teacher and the governing body.

The school holds a stock of school sweatshirts, polo shirts, fleeces, trousers and book bags. Orders for these are also taken each term. Please contact Mrs. Redford or reception.

**Girls**

Brown skirt or pinafore of approximately knee length  
or  
Brown tailored trousers or brown tailored shorts

White polo t-shirt or white school blouse

School brown sweatshirt or brown cardigan

School brown fleece (for outdoor wear only)

Brown, white, black or grey socks or tights

Yellow and white checked dress (optional for Summer term and during hot weather at other times)

Black or brown shoes – flat and sturdy

No boots, trainers or plimsolls

In the Summer term, black, brown or white sandals can be worn which have a heel strap that holds the shoe firmly on the foot.

In bad weather, wellington boots or similar can be worn outside (including to and from school).

**Boys**

Brown tailored trousers or brown tailored shorts

White polo t-shirt or white school shirt

School brown sweatshirt or brown jumper

School brown fleece (for outdoor wear only)

Brown, black or grey socks

Black or brown shoes – flat and sturdy

No boots, trainers or plimsolls

In the Summer term, black or brown sandals can be worn which have a heel strap that holds the shoe firmly on the foot.

In bad weather, wellington boots or similar can be worn outside (including to and from school).

## **PE**

Black shorts, plain white t-shirt, trainers or plimsolls. Girls wearing tights to school should also have socks to change into. Black, grey or navy tracksuit trousers can be worn in cold weather.

## **Hair**

Hair colouring, hair gel and patterns cut into the hair are not appropriate for school.

Long hair should be tied back / up.

Brown, yellow or white hairbands or scrunchies.

Head scarves or hair coverings worn for religious or cultural reasons should be black, brown or white.

## **Jewellery and Make Up**

Small discrete stud earrings are the only ones permitted and should be taken out for P.E, games and any other physical activity. If children are unable to remove their own earrings, they should be removed at home before children are sent to school. If they cannot be taken out by the pupil, they should be covered with micropore tape (brought from home) for P.E lessons. No earrings (or any other sort of jewellery) can be worn for swimming.

Watches are brought to school at the owner's risk and must be taken off for games and PE.

No other jewellery should be worn, although a small item of religious significance is permitted, but should be removed for P.E. lessons.

No make up or nail varnish should be worn.

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
