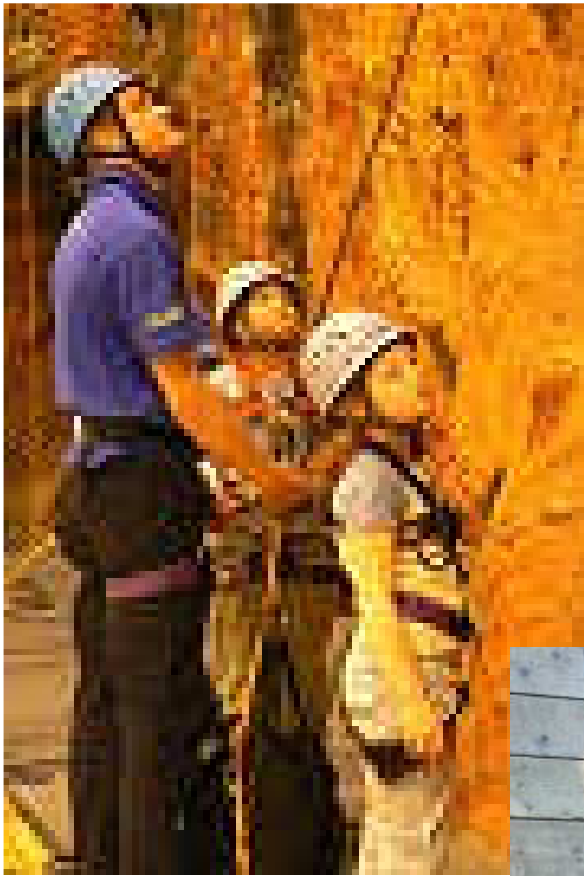


Ground Rules
